## Fair Checks

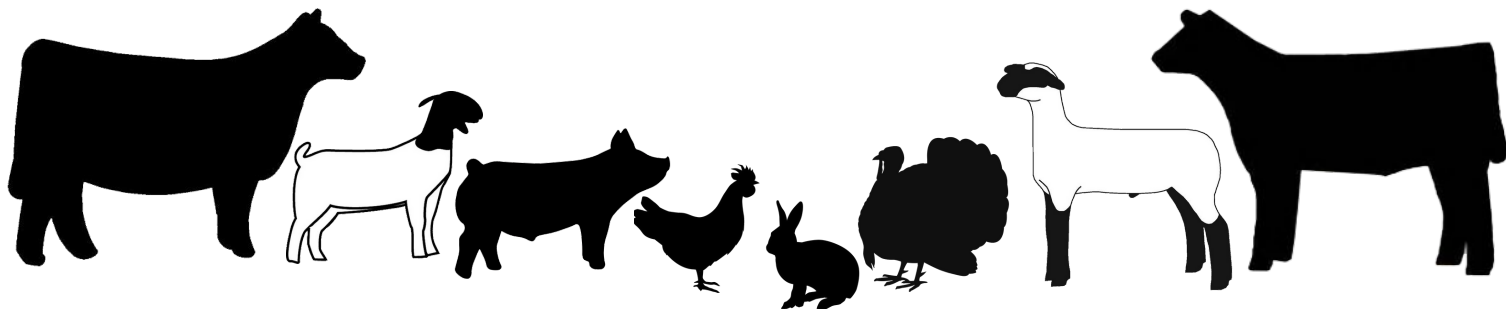
Fair Checks are now available to be picked up  
from the Extension Office

Office Hours: Monday-Friday, 8-12, 1-5

### Approximate Guideline for Calhoun County Fair Market Animals

- **Market Steers**
  - Approx. 14-18 months old on show day\*
  - Validation - March
- **Market Sheep/Market Goats**
  - Approx. 8-10 months old on show day\*
  - MUST have their milk teeth
  - Validation - June
- **Market Swine**
  - Approx. 6-7 months old on show day\*
  - Validation - June
- **Poultry**
  - Order **Turkeys** - March
    - Arrive in May
  - Order **Roasters** - June (8 weeks old on show day)
    - Arrive in August
  - Order **Broilers** - June (6 weeks old on show day)
    - Arrive in September
- **Rabbits**
  - MAXIMUM of 70 days old on show day
    - Talk with breeder around May
  - Validation - September

\* - age will vary based upon personal preference  
Recommended to own animals at least 1-2 months before validation

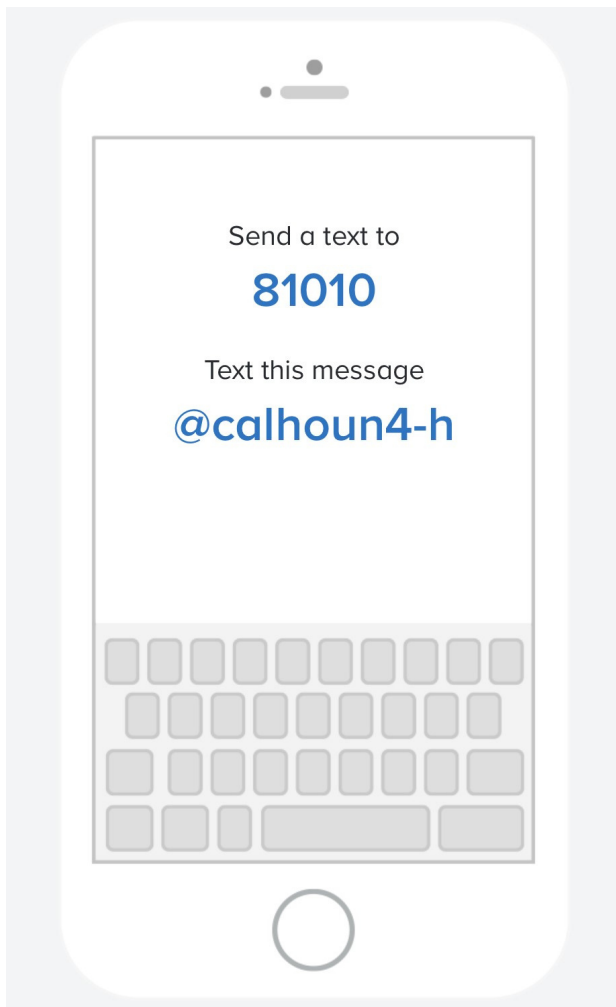

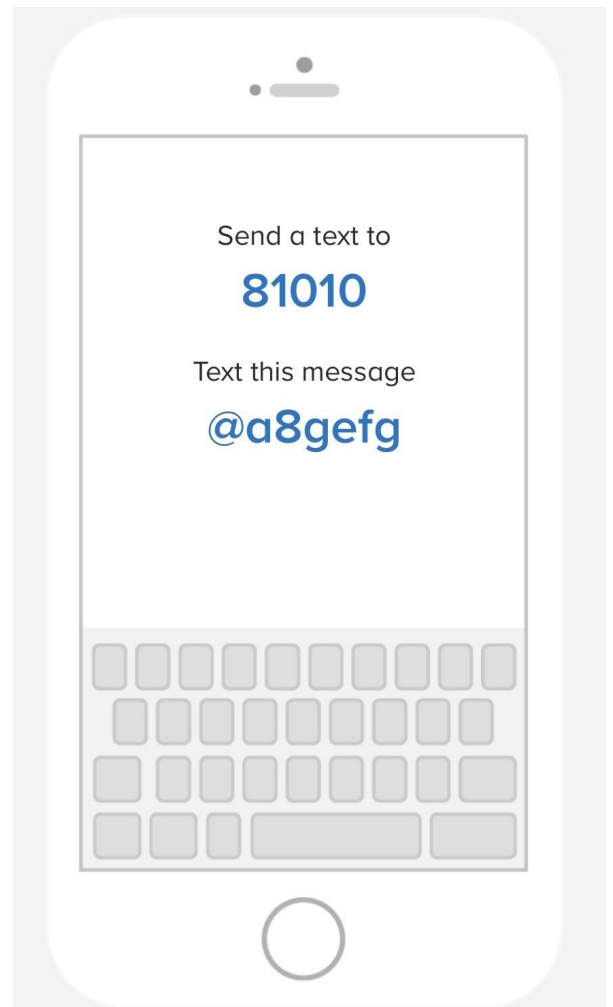
