Public Speaking

In Public Speaking youth prepare a 5-7 minute speech . Speech categories include Agricultural Policy/ Agribusiness, Animal Science, Horticulture/Landscape/Natural Resources, Western Heritage/Ag Advocacy.

Ag Product ID

Ag Product ID is a Contest where youth have to correctly Identify and answer a question about Agriculture products such as, Almond, Beet, Olive, Persimmon, Rib eye, pork loin, etc.

Quiz Bowl

Quiz Bowl lets youth show off their knowledge of subject matter in a gameshow style format. Youth race to buzz in first to answer questions on specific subject. 4-H has quiz bowl contests in Beef, Swine, Equine, and Nutrition.

Youth Identify common name and genus, of insects common to our area.




