The Calhoun County office of the Texas A&M AgriLife Extension Service will be offering a Private Applicator Training Course to assist those interested in obtaining a license.

If interested, please stop by the Calhoun County Extension office to purchase your study materials at a cost of \$40 (cash or check only). There is also a \$10 registration fee (cash or check only) the day of training.

A private pesticide applicator is someone who uses or supervises the use of restricted-use or state-limited-use pesticides or regulated herbicides to produce an agricultural commodity on:

- Personally owned property;
- Rented property;
- Property owned by his or her employer;
- Property under his or her general control; or
- The property of another person if applied without compensation, other than the trading of personal services between producers of agricultural commodities.

An agricultural commodity is a plant or animal grown for sale, lease, barter, feed or human consumption and animals raised for farm or ranch work. No license is required to apply gen-eral-use pesticides to produce agricultural commodities.
