

Tips on How to Write Thank You Letters

TIP 1: GREETING. Make sure you spell the name of individual(s) correctly.

- Dear Mr. & Mrs. Smith,
- Dear Mr. Doofenschmirtz,
- TIP 2: EXPRESS YOUR THANKS. Begin with the two most important words:
 - Thank You. Thank you so much for...
 - I'm so grateful you...
- **TIP 3: ADD SPECIFIC DETAILS.** Tell them how you plan to use their gift. It shows you really appreciate the thought that went into it.
 - I can't wait to put this money towards a new 4-H project next year.
 - I plan to put some of the money in savings for college.
- **TIP 4: LOOK AHEAD.** Mention the next time you might see them, or just let them know you're thinking of them.
 - I hope to see you next year at the 2024 Calhoun County Fair.
- TIP 5: RESTATE YOUR THANKS. Add details to thank them in a different way.
 Again, thank you so much for your generosity...
- TIP 6: END WITH YOUR REGARDS. "Sincerely" is a safe standby, but other options may be used. End the letter by signing your name after the regards of your choice. Sincerely.

Applicable for 4-H Members only. Excludes Clover Kids and Adult Volunteers.


